

# **Traffic Advisory**

## **Country Club Elementary School**

Our first priority at Country Club is the safety of our students. Please read and follow these traffic regulations for the safest most efficient pick up and drop off experience.

### **Traffic Bus Transportation**

We are one of four schools in our area participating in the Traffix program. Traffix is a student bus transportation service to reduce traffic congestion provided by the Measure J Traffic Congestion Relief Agency. Information can be found at [www.RideTRAFFIX.com](http://www.RideTRAFFIX.com).

Due to the accommodations needed for busses:

- The white curb zone in front of the school on Blue Fox is a bus zone.
- The parking lot will be closed off prior to pick up time when the curb lane is full. This is to allow emergency access to the school.
- Cars will not be allowed to block traffic on Blue Fox Way while waiting to pick up students. You will need to time your arrival for when the traffic starts to flow or you will have to drive and turn around.
- The best way to deal with traffic is to have your student ride the bus, carpool, or park and walk.

### **The following regulations are not new but are very important:**

- Our traffic patterns are very predictable. Please stay calm and patient.
- Always be safe and drive slowly in the school zone. No cell phones or other distractions.
- Make sure your student is ready to exit the car quickly in the morning.
- Only drop off or pick up students when your car is in the curb lane.
- Follow the directions of staff members. We are here to help.
- Pull forward as far as possible.
- Pedestrians - do not cross the driveways. Go around the parking lot instead.
- When crossing Blue Fox Way **use the crosswalks**. Do not cross in the middle of the street.
- May Way is a great alternative drop and pick up spot.

- Discuss the plan for pick up with your student so they know where to look for you.
- The school parking lots are for staff only. Please use street parking.
- There are “no parking” zones along the red curb in the parking lot, along the white curb on Blue Fox way in front of school, and the coned and signed area on Blue Fox Way near Davona. Respect them.
- Blue Fox Way becomes two westbound lanes near Davona. The left goes straight or left. The right lane is for right turns.

The San Ramon Police will have an active role in enforcing our traffic and safety initiatives.
